Redtail Ridge Farm is proud to host six world-class clinicians at the farm with instruction in three-day eventing, showjumping and dressage. This year's line-up includes:

- August 10 & 11: Jumper clinic with **Scott Keach** X_____
- August 17 & 18: Eventing clinic with **Bruce Mandeville** (with optional dressage instruction on August 16 for an additional fee) X_____
- August 31 and September 1: Eventing clinic with **Buck Davidson** X_____
- September 14 & 15: Dressage clinic with **Silva Martin** X_____

Please check next to the clinician's name which entry form you are filling out.

The **cost** to participate in each two-day clinic is \$300/horse; additional dressage instruction with Bruce Mandeville is \$75/horse. Riders may ride more than one horse in a clinic. In order to ensure quality, entry is limited. Riders' lunches are included in the clinic fee. The **cost to audit** a clinic for two days is \$25/day or \$45 for two days.

Stabling is not included in the fee. Redtail Ridge can provide very limited stabling at a cost of \$35/night. Stabling includes bedded stall on arrival. Additional bedding, feed and mucking are not included.

Directions to Redtail Ridge Farm (6066 Northridge Road, Johnstown)

-From I-270 in Central Ohio take OH 161 East approximately 13 miles to the OH 37 West exit toward Johnstown. Turn left off the ramp onto OH 37 West. In the Village of Alexandria, take a right at the Marathon gas station onto Northridge Road. The driveway to Redtail Ridge Farm, 6066 Northridge Road, is 3.4 miles on the right.

-Alternate Route: take 670 East to US 62 East into and through the Village of Johnstown. Take a right at the blinking light onto Sportsmans Club Road to the four-way stop at Northridge Road. Take a right onto Northridge. Redtail Ridge is approximately one mile down Northridge on the left.

All riders must wear ATSM-approved safety helmets with chinstrap; a safety vest must be worn for the cross-country schooling. All horses must have a valid negative Coggins drawn within the last nine months; all riders must sign a waiver before mounting. Water will be available for horses. **As always, please clean up after your horse.**

LIABILITY WAIVER**

I hereby for myself, and for my child or ward if signed by a parent or guardian, waive any and all claims against Redtail Ridge Farm LLC, SWC Farms LLC, instructors, employees or agents, for any and all injuries or damages suffered in relation to equine activities. I acknowledge that equine activities involve certain inherent risks, including, but not limited to:

Ohio Statement of Inherent Risks:

"INHERENT RISK OF AN EQUINE ACTIVITY" MEANS A DANGER OR CONDITION THAT IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF AN EQUINE ACTIVITY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

(a) THE PROPENSITY OF AN EQUINE TO BEHAVE IN WAYS THAT MAY RESULT IN INJURY, DEATH, OR LOSS TO PERSONS ON OR AROUND THE EQUINE;

(b) THE UNPREDICTABILITY OF AN EQUINE'S REACTION TO SOUNDS, SUDDEN MOVEMENT, UNFAMILIAR OBJECTS, PERSONS, OR OTHER ANIMALS;

(c) HAZARDS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SURFACE OR SUBSURFACE CONDITIONS;

(d) A COLLISION WITH ANOTHER EQUINE, ANOTHER ANIMAL, A PERSON, OR AN OBJECT;

(e) THE POTENTIAL OF AN EQUINE ACTIVITY PARTICIPANT TO ACT IN A NEGLIGENT MANNER THAT MAY CONTRIBUTE TO INJURY, DEATH, OR LOSS TO THE PERSON OF THE PARTICIPANT OR TO OTHER PERSONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, FAILING TO MAINTAIN CONTROL OVER AN EQUINE OR FAILING TO ACT WITHIN THE ABILITY OF THE PARTICIPANT."

I further acknowledge that reasonable inquiry was made regarding my (or my child's or ward's if signed by a parent or guardian) experience with equines including the ability to safely engage in equine activities and to safely manage an equine.
